

Alumni Feedback Report

Academic Year: 2023-24

Objective:

Methodology:

Data for this report was collected through offline feedback forms distributed to alumni as well as from online goggle forms. Respondents were randomly selected from the alumni database, achieving a response rate of approximately 55%.

Key Insights:

Curriculum:

Faculty:

The majority of alumni commended the quality of teaching and the guidance provided by faculty members. Despite this, some alumni recommended improvements in faculty approachability and responsiveness to student concerns.

Infrastructure:

Alumni rated the institution's infrastructure, including the library, laboratories, and classrooms, very positively, highlighting these facilities as significant strengths.

Placement Opportunities:

Feedback regarding placement opportunities was mixed. While some alumni were satisfied with their job placements, others felt that the placement cell could benefit from improvements in its processes and support services.

Alumni Network:

The institution's alumni network was highly rated by respondents. Many alumni expressed a keen interest in remaining connected with the institution and actively participating in alumni events and activities.

The overall feedback indicates that our institution performs well in key areas such as curriculum, faculty, infrastructure, and the alumni network. However, there are several areas that require attention, notably the incorporation of more industry-focused and practical courses, as well as enhancing placement support services. Addressing these areas will not only strengthen the student experience but also better equip tangengraduates for success in their careers.

A total of 30 alumni shared their feedback which mentioned below:-





































Conclusion:


Student Support:

Conclusion:




Conclusion

By addressing these areas, we can further enrich the professional environment for our teachers, fostering motivation and enabling them to continue delivering high-quality education to our students.












