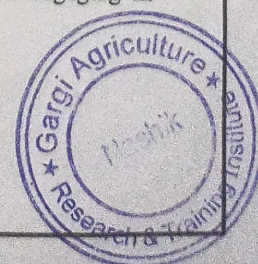

Decision-Making Ability: The ability to make swift and informed decisions can greatly impact success in competitive scenarios.

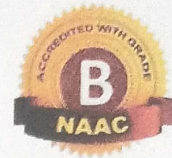

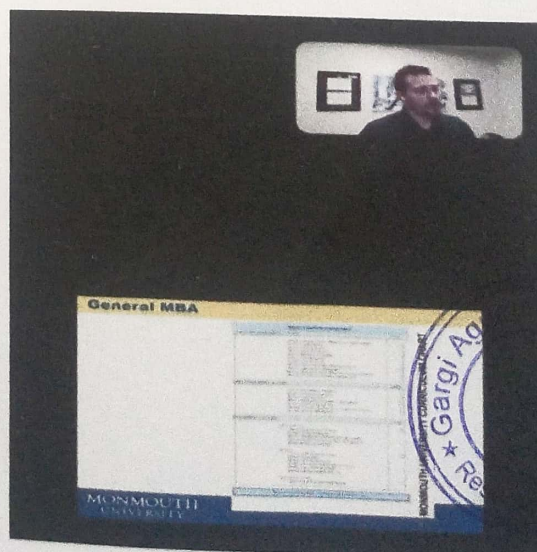
Conclusion:

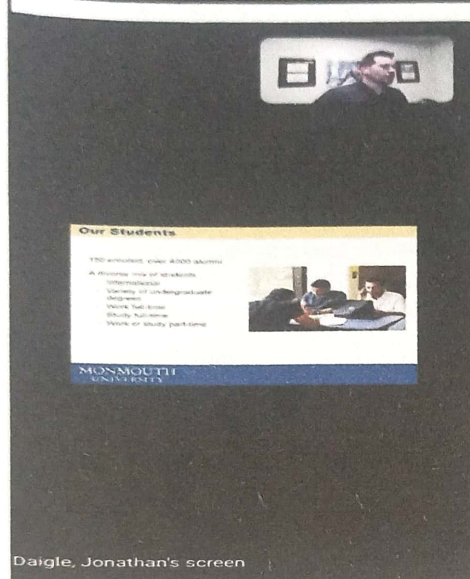


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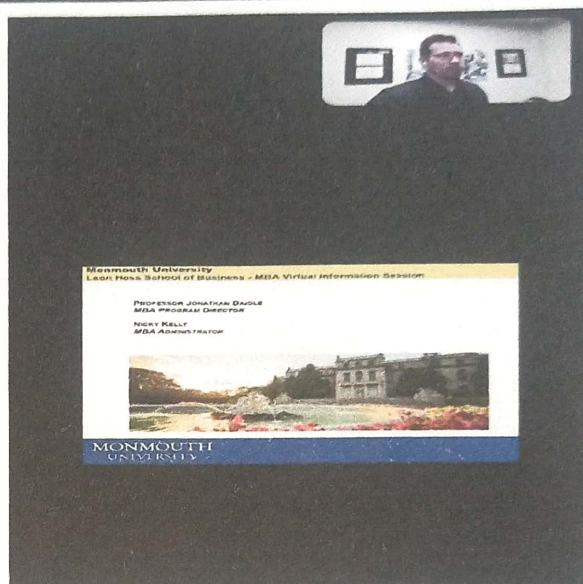

Guidance on how to register for the Career Katta app, ensuring that students can access a plethora of career resources, mentorship programs, and networking opportunities.

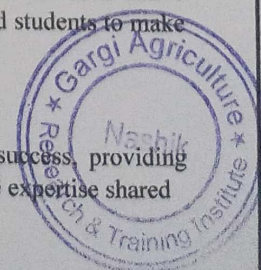
Personalized advice to help students make informed decisions regarding their career paths, including tips on skill development and professional networking.
